PROJECT PURPOSE AND METHODOLOGY

This study was commissioned by the Colorado Institute of Technology (CIT) as part of its Homeland Security Initiative. The purpose of this study was to:

- Develop a database of organizations conducting homeland security research in Colorado;
- Develop a database of organizations providing services or selling homeland security products in Colorado; and
- Identify a preliminary set of issues related to conducting homeland security research and business in Colorado.

To better understand the organizations conducting research, selling products, or providing homeland security services, information was compiled from a mail survey, focus groups in Denver and Colorado Springs, individual interviews, and extensive secondary research. Data were collected for corporations, academic groups, and federal facilities.

This white paper provides a brief historical perspective of homeland security in Colorado; research disciplines and topics, workforce skills; strengths of the industry and challenges it faces in Colorado; and cluster growth opportunities as defined by the industry. HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

Organizational Perspective

Homeland security, defense, and aerospace have been integral parts of the Colorado economy for more than 50 years. With its location on the I-25 atomic corridor, Colorado became a critical part of U.S. weapons production when Rocky Flats began manufacturing components for nuclear weapons in 1952. Ball Aerospace was formed in 1956 as a spinoff from the University of Colorado at Boulder. NORAD was founded two year later. Lockheed Martin, Northrop Grumman, and Raytheon have maintained a strong presence in Colorado for a number of years.

Through the years the homeland security cluster has quietly built on this foundation. Research conducted for this project revealed that the cluster now works with such diverse industries as agriculture/bio, game theory, and laser technology. The focal points for homeland security research are Colorado State University, each of the campuses in the University of Colorado system, and the University of Denver. In particular, the Center for Disease Control is located at Colorado State University, the Natural Hazards Research and Applications Information Center is located at the University of Colorado at Boulder, and the University of Denver houses the Rocky Mountain Center for Homeland Defense.

From an industry perspective, about 200 Colorado companies have been identified that conduct research, provide services, or sell products related to homeland security. This number is likely to expand as the cluster receives greater attention and federal funding. As a result of the 2005 hurricane season, homeland security will be looked at as being more than a cluster with strong ties to defense and aerospace. The listing of companies identified by this study point out that homeland security includes financial, software, and construction companies in addition to the manufacturers and research and development organization.

Indeed, activity in the cluster has already been increasing in 2005. Although Lockheed Martin announced that part of its manufacturing operation has moved out of state, it will likely transfer 1,000 workers to Colorado to work on the Atlas V rocket. In addition, Northrop Grumman has announced that it will expand its facilities in Aurora by 300 workers and may add 2,000 employees to the Colorado Springs workforce in 2006 and beyond. At the 2006 Southern Colorado Economic Forum, the presenters cited the development of two defense parks as economic drivers for the Colorado Springs community.

Government Perspective

Federal homeland security funding for state and local prevention, preparation, and response to terrorism was \$2.708 billion in 2001. In 2004, it was \$7.426 billion—a surge of more than 300% in only three years. This same funding growth has been seen in the homeland security research area. In 2001, research funding for homeland security at the federal level was conducted within individual agencies. In 2002, when the Department of Homeland Security's Science and Technology Directorate were formed, it received \$200 million in funding. The directorate identified BioWatch, BioShield, BioSurveillance, Integrated Wireless (IWN), and Explosives Detection as the research programs for 2005, with \$1 billion in the budget for research.

The growth of homeland security in Colorado has followed a similar growth pattern. Where Homeland Security was largely unknown in 2001, the 2005 budget included homeland security funding for just under \$37 billion.

During 2003, the homeland security initiatives for Colorado were defined as:

- Intelligence and warning
- Border and transportation security
- Domestic counterterrorism
- Protecting critical Infrastructure and key assets
- Defend against catastrophic threats
- Emergency preparedness and response

The homeland security strategy presented in 2005 further defined these goals and objectives, and developed action plans and accountability procedures.

Research in Colorado, which has been conducted by federal facilities, corporations, and academic institutions, has grown exponentially over the last five years. In 2003, the CU University System was fifth in federal funding among public research universities, with a total funding amount of \$560.9 million. Three percent of this amount was for research in the area of defense. Two years later, the Colorado State University CO-Grid award alone was \$1.8 million in the new area of biosecurity. Within federal labs, in 2005, \$350,000 was awarded by the U.S. Coast Guard to the National Renewable Energy Lab (NREL) to conduct research involving renewable energy to safeguard infrastructure.

ANALYSIS OF RESEARCH RESULTS

Research Disciplines, Areas, and Skills

An analysis of the research results revealed the following disciplines as areas of importance to homeland security in Colorado:

- Animal and plant pathology
- Biology—microbiology, chemical biological counterterrorism, molecular biology, bio-technology, army training in biohazard management
- Construction
- Design and manufacture of composite particles for various products
- Engineering—systems, chemical, and aerospace, development of small satellites with multiple intelligence payloads
- Game theory
- Geographic information systems
- Infrastructure design
- Integrated pest management technicians
- Optics—Laser optic physics, opto-mechanical design, design and development of laser subsystems and laser radar systems, sensor development
- RF/mixed signal integrated circuit design
- Transportation—Design of vehicles and their power systems that can be used to detect, find, fight, and destroy terrorists
- Veterinary medicine—Epidemiological and foreign animal disease diagnostics

Within these disciplines, more specific topical areas of significance are:

- Analysis of framework design
- Bioterrorism vaccines
- Computer security; specialized operations and analysis
- Counter proliferation
- Custom instrumentation, measurements, photometric and photo-instrumentation capabilities

- Defense and advanced reasoning technologies
- Digital communication wireless patents
- Disaster societal impacts analysis
- Integration systems expertise
- Knowledge of the transportation industry
- Open source intelligence
- Relational data management
- Sensor technology space-based systems; gas detection and infrared technology
- Specialized experience in force protection and vulnerability assessments
- Target vulnerability
- Terminal ballistics

A sampling of the more predominant skills needed for work in these disciplines and topical areas include the following:

- Communication skills
- Digital data security
- Manufacture and use of small, portable GPS devices and scintillation detectors
- Mapping
- Multispectral imagery exploitation
- Noninvasive diagnostics using laser remote sensing and laser radar technologies
- Provide first responder equipment and produce prototype mountings and accessories for improvement of law enforcement aircraft
- Retrofitting
- Risk assessment
- Signal processing, communicational, and statistical algorithms
- Structural health monitoring
- Weather, transport and diffusion, and scientific modelings; computer science and artificial intelligence; and development of new game theory applicable to solving large-scale defense problems

Colorado Homeland Security Research Strengths

The homeland security cluster is part of Colorado's concentration of high-tech workers. Approximately 7% of state firms can be defined as high-tech based on their NAICS classification. These firms account for about 10% of total nonagricultural wage and salary employment and approximately 19% of total wages.

Organizations in the Colorado homeland security cluster benefit from Colorado's highly educated workforce. Nearly 87% of Coloradans older than 25 have a high school education, and 32.7% have at least a bachelor's degree. Homeland security business leaders have identified Colorado's workforce as its greatest strength, describing it as well-trained, flexible, and dynamic.

Of almost equal importance is the presence of the military, nuclear cleanup sites, and the aerospace industry in Colorado, specifically, NORTHCOM, NORAD, Ball Aerospace, and Lockheed Martin. These facilities are complemented by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Laboratory in Fort Collins and the Federal Center in Denver.

Colorado business leaders also value the proximity of the University of Colorado system, Colorado State University, the University of Denver, and other higher education institutions. Moreover, it was pointed out that the presence of a variety of technology clusters in the state, such as the biotech industry, is valuable to researchers. Because the state's high-tech workforce has varied skills and most workers enjoy the lifestyle the state offers, they are willing to learn new skills or move between companies and clusters as a means of continuing to live in Colorado.

Although Colorado's quality of life was identified as an asset in maintaining and recruiting companies to the state, it is usually recognized as a secondary asset for most high-tech companies. Other strengths include the following:

- The state's geographic center location
- Strength in GPS, telecommunications, and cable networks
- Success in winning SBIR funding (ranked third nationwide)
- Presence of large corporations with federal contract experience

Colorado Homeland Security Research Challenges

The challenges identified by homeland security researchers fall into three broad categories: obtaining funding, generating contract sales, and operating a business.

Funding was undoubtedly the most frequently cited challenge identified by corporate and academic researchers. Many small business owners and academicians lack the skills necessary to start a new business, particularly one that almost totally depends on government funding. In addition, some academicians are frustrated with the need to commercialize their research as a means of generating income to continue their research.

Some business leaders, representing firms of all sizes, expressed concern that some of Colorado's elected officials do not understand how to appropriately support the organizations in the homeland security cluster. This is a concern that has been echoed in past studies of the defense- and aerospace-related clusters in Colorado.

A portion of the funding challenges relate to the fact that the Department of Homeland Security is a new entity and that its strategies are not defined well. Given that the products and services in this sector have very specific target customers, the lack of defined requirements is frustrating.

Small-business owners indicated they are at a disadvantage because of the need to access procurement contacts within federal agencies in Washington. In most cases, business leaders recognize the value of university research and are amenable to working with

higher education institutions as a means of gaining access to their research. Periodically, business leaders have been frustrated by university red tape (hiring processes, clearances, tech transfer policies).

Cluster Growth Opportunities as Defined by the Organization Leaders

Despite these challenges, Colorado companies have a sense of optimism related to the cluster's growth in the next three to five years, particularly in Colorado Springs. Organization leaders are very passionate about their products, services, and research. These individuals offered a variety of suggestions for fostering the growth of the homeland security cluster in the state. See the items below.

- Improve communications within the cluster:
 - Provide a forum for idea sharing and business development cooperation
 - Publicize RFPs and research being developed
 - Increase promotion of Colorado businesses
 - Provide opportunities to network with other Colorado groups
 - Facilitate opportunities for identifying sources of funding and or contracts
 - Promote the SBIR effort
 - Improve communications with federal groups, such as NORTHCOM
- Increase interaction and support from the federal government:
 - Encourage better organization of DHS, allowing Colorado companies and government leaders to focus their priorities
 - Involve universities in the Homeland Security Institute in Washington
 - Identify individual(s) with security clearances who could represent the cluster
 - Establish focus areas for the state to pursue centers of excellence
 - Develop cooperation between state and federal leaders to use Colorado's competencies
- Increase support from state government:
 - Encourage elected officials to provide support for homeland security companies and drive federal funding to Colorado
 - Establish R&D state sales tax refund, manufacturing equipment exemptions, or enterprise zone tax benefits for homeland security research similar to those established for bioscience industry
 - Change the state's reputation from being a leader in telecommunications to being a leader in homeland security
 - Focus a portion of the state economic development effort on recruiting technology-based companies that complement the homeland security cluster

- Strengthen cluster cooperation:
 - Develop joint industry/university programs
 - Build partnerships to pursue large federal contracts
 - Facilitate university tech-transfer with the arena
 - Further improve the linkages between academic research, industry, and key government constituents
 - Develop a consortium that includes industry and academia
- Build on current strengths:
 - Build on the fact that 9 of the top 50 government contractors have a large presence in the state and 5 of the top 10 defense contractors have significant personnel in Colorado.
 - Offer support for higher education because it provides the trained workforce and conducts excellent research
 - Encourage universities to work together as a means of tapping into the \$3 billion earmarked for homeland security training

This study will help provide a better understanding of the type of organizations operating in the state cluster. This knowledge combined with the comments of industry leaders will hopefully be useful in addressing specific issues. In particular the composition of the cluster, by major NAICS codes follows:

- 40.4% Professional, Scientific and Technical
- 20.7% Manufacturing
- 13.5% Education
- 8.7% Information
- 8.7% Public Administration
- 8.0% Miscellaneous

Slightly more than 60% of the organizations indicated that they conduct research. These organizations are classified as follows:

- 37.6% Professional, Scientific and Technical
- 21.8% Education
- 19.4% Manufacturing
- 11.2% Public Administration
- 6.5% Information
- 3.5% Other

CONCLUSION

The threat of terrorism is just as real today as it was before September 11, 2001. Given that more than four years have since passed, many homeland security experts feel that the country is not as prepared as it should be. Unfortunately, events such as Hurricane Katrina

Katrina are a subtle reminder that additional research, products, and services are necessary and that homeland security means much more than defense, aerospace, or protection from terrorism.

As the U.S. homeland security cluster moves through its lifecycle toward a mature stage and leaders learn from recent natural disasters and terrorist attacks in other countries, new products and services will be derived from company, university, and federal lab research efforts. While much of the current research is being funded by federal agencies, ultimately, growth in the sector will probably evolve to the point where most will be funded by the private sector.

Much of the concern about the perceived lack of preparedness centers around the fact that about 85% of the country's infrastructure is owned and maintained by the private sector. Most businesses do not have comprehensive plans that include mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery. As homeland security standards are prepared for each of these four phase in the various sectors of the economy such as finance, utilities, manufacturing, health care, and transportation, numerous opportunities will arise to provide research, services, and products to help companies comply with these homeland security standards.

Some homeland security experts believe that businesses and even communities will be able to develop a competitive advantage based on their homeland security competencies. At some point, those competencies may be viewed as favorably as quality of life or having an educated workforce.

Defense, aerospace, and the aspects of homeland security related to these clusters have been a part of the Colorado economy for more than 50 years. They provide a strong foundation for the growth of the cluster from Colorado Springs to Fort Collins. It will be necessary for Colorado government, university, and business leaders to first understand the economic development and safety opportunities available in homeland security before they can effectively foster its growth in Colorado. The combination of varied technologybased clusters, federal and higher education research, and Colorado's cowboy entrepreneurial spirit potentially can serve as a strong stimulus to the Colorado economy, in addition to making the state a safer place to live. From both a supply and demand side, it appears that Colorado is favorably positioned to take advantage of the country's needs for improved homeland security.
